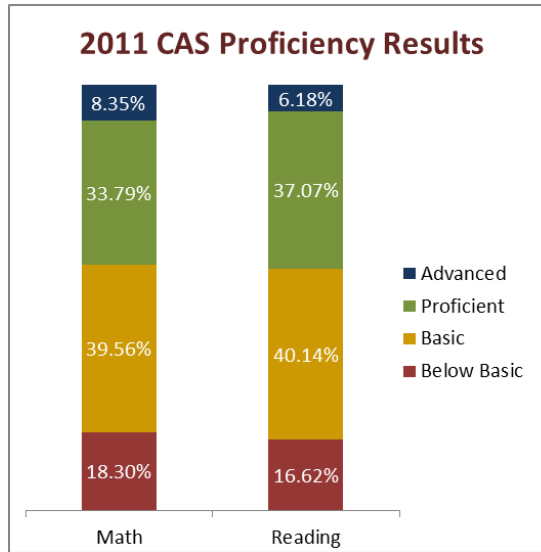


## Ward 5 Quick Facts

### ACHIEVEMENT

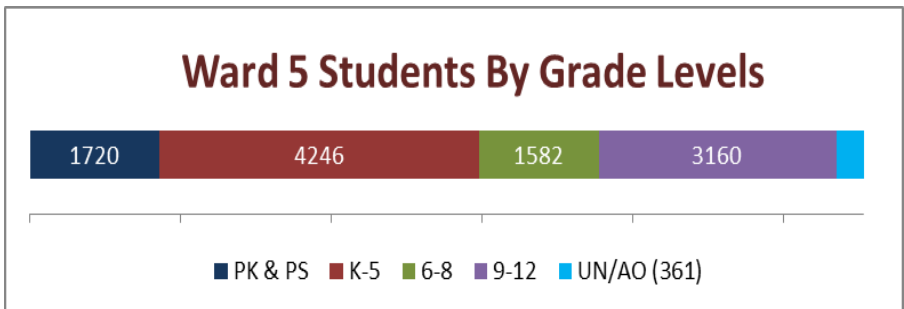


In 2010, **4783 students** were eligible for the DC CAS proficiency test. Of that, **98.6%** tested for both sections.

In 2011, **5042 students** were eligible for the DC CAS proficiency test. Of that, **98.2%** tested for the reading portion and **98.1%** tested for the math portion.
