What is PARCC?

- PARCC stands for the Partnership for Assessment of Readiness for College and Careers
- This statewide assessment replaces the DC-CAS assessment and provides a new baseline for performance of students in the District of Columbia

Background

- DC students and students in 11 other states took PARCC in the 2014-15 school year
 - AR, CO, IL, LA, MD, MA, MS, NJ, NM, OH, RI
- Required 2014-15 PARCC assessments:
 - English language arts/literacy and math in grades 3-8
 - English II and Geometry/Integrated Math II in high school

What is NCSC?

- NCSC is the National Center and State Collaborative assessment aligned to the Common Core State Standards
- NCSC's long-term goal is to ensure that students with significant cognitive disabilities achieve increasingly higher academic outcomes and leave high school ready for post-secondary options

How Did Scott Score in ELA Categories?




How Does Scott's Performance Compare Over Time?

The last ELA test that Scott took was the Grade 4 DC CAS. This report does not make a direct comparison between the PARCC and DC CAS because they are very different tests. First, the scoring and performance levels are different. Second, the PARCC is considered more challenging because of the real-world questions that measure the knowledge and skills students need to succeed in their grade, and ultimately in college and careers.



How Does Scott's Score Compare to Peers?


Compared to other 5th Grade students tested on this year's PARCC, Scott scored better than this percentage of students:
